

Call before you dig!



Whether you're landscaping, installing fence posts, or building a deck, hitting an underground gas line or other utility lines can be dangerous and expensive. Whenever you're digging, it's important to know where your gas lines are located before you start.

Before digging, call BC ONE CALL at **1-800-474-6886** to request underground line information. Plan ahead. Call at least three business days before you dig.

Provincial regulations require you to hand dig to expose buried lines before using any mechanical excavation equipment like an auger or backhoe.

So please, always call before you dig.

Right of way safety

Our large natural gas transmission pipelines are installed underground in corridors of land called “rights of way.” These areas are clearly marked with distinctive orange signs that warn that a buried pipeline is in the area. The exact location must always be verified by FortisBC before you dig. If you need to dig near a right of way—you must call BC ONE CALL first.
